Introduction to James. After the analysis regarding all the literary, historical and theological issues concerning the text, it provides translation, literary analysis, and commentary under the following headings: be persevering in tests (1:1-18); hear and act upon the word (1:19-27); carry out the 'royal law' (2:1-13); faith without works is dead (2:14-26); the tongue sets on fire the cycle of existence (3:1-12); wisdom from above is pure (3:13-18); humble yourselves before the Lord (4:1-12); woe to you, rich! (4:13-5:6); and strengthen your hearts (5:7-20).
