G. BARBAGLIO, *Emozioni e sentimenti di Gesù* (Bologna: Dehoniane, 2009, paper €23.90) 268 pp. ISBN: 978-88-10-22137-2.

This volume contains twenty-five essays by Barbaglio (1934-2007) on various biblical themes and texts under two major headings: the feelings of Jesus (sixteen), and the church of Jesus (nine). Their topics include the emotions and sentiments of Jesus; the gentleness of Jesus; the image of God as father in Jesus' vision; Christ as the principle of peace; Jesus and Paul vis-à-vis sickness and suffering; relationships between protagonists in Jesus' parables; Gospel figures of waiting; fright and fear; biblical testimony about walking along the way; *parrēsia* in the NT; conscience, freedom, and *agapē*; the cup in the NT; the poetry in Jesus' parables; the love of God in John's message; Jesus of Nazareth and the reality of the church; the Spirit of God in Paul's letters; conflicts and reconciliation in the early Christian community; eternal life and resurrection of the flesh in the NT; and Paul in dialogue with the Greek culture of his time.
