The Italian version of *Quand Luc raconte. Le récit comme théologie* [NTA 42, p. 577], this volume contains an introduction and a reflection on “witness,” along with essays on God’s place in the Lukan narrative; Jesus and his disciples—reasons for a parallelism; the gospel and its heralds—the idea of witness; the gospel and those addressed by it—Israel and the nations in Luke-Acts; and the narrative as theology—the father and his two sons (Lk 15:11-32). The two appendixes deal with the composition of Acts and the steps in narrative analysis. Aletti is professor of NT exegesis at the Pontifical Biblical Institute in Rome.
