1550. ALBERTO MELLO, *La solitudine del credente* (Biblica; Bologna: EDB, 2010). Pp. 128. €11.50. ISBN 978-88-10-22146-4.

M.'s volume consists of 11 brief chapters that offer reflections on the theme of solitude in the life of the believer as this is exemplified in a series of biblical texts, mostly from the OT. The chapters originally appeared in the Italian journal *Parola, spirito, et vita*. They were written in Jerusalem and draw heavily on Jewish tradition's understanding(s) of the passages treated. M.'s chapter titles are as follows: Adam, where are you?; Babel and Jerusalem; Abraham, the morning man; the binding of Isaac; the recognition of Joseph; the prayer of Moses; Elijah and the voice of silence; Isaiah and violence; Jeremiah's fear; Jesus' solitude; and the Suffering Servant in Jewish interpretation.—C.T.B.
