M. GRILLI, *L'opera di Luca*. Vol. 1, *Il Vangelo del viandante*, Biblica (Bologna: Dehoniane, 2012, paper €14) 152 pp. ISBN: 978-88-10-22158-7.

After an introduction to Luke's work and the way of the word, Grilli, author of *Scriba dell'Antico e del Nuovo. Il Vangelo di Matteo* (2011), considers the following parts of Luke's Gospel: the beginnings (Luke 1–2); the hymns in Luke 1–2; the program for the journey (4:16–30); the wayfarers—Jesus and his disciples (4:31–6:16); people encountered along the way—pagans, widows, tax collectors and sinners, and women (6:17–8:3); the call to responsibility (8:4–9:50); the way toward Jerusalem (9:51–13:21); the miserable and mercy (15); the righteous use of unrighteous mammon (16:1–13); death on the cross under the sign of forgiveness (23:33–49); and the beginning of a new journey (24:1–53).
