LEONARDO GIULIANO, Un paradigma inesplorato: Retorica e teologia del numerale UNO nelle lettere di Paolo, Supplementi alla Rivista Biblica 61 (Bologna: Dehoniane, 2016, paper €35.60) 323 pp. Bibliography. Indexed. ISBN: 978-88-10-30249-1.

The slightly revised version of a doctoral dissertation supervised by A. M. Buscemi and accepted by the Studium Biblicum Franciscanum in 2015, this study investigates the literary recurrence of the numeral "one" ($\epsilon \tilde{i}\zeta$, $\mu i\alpha$, and ϵv) in the Pauline corpus, focusing on its rhetorical impact (in relation to the nouns of reference) in Paul's argument and thought. After an eight-page introduction, it discusses the thirty-four instances of the forty-seven occurrences of the masculine numeral $\epsilon \tilde{i}\zeta$ where it functions as a cardinal number (1 Cor 8:4, 6; 9:24; 10:17; 14:27; 2 Cor 5:14; 11:2; Gal 3:20, 28; etc.). Then it considers the ten instances of the thirteen occurrences of the feminine numeral $\mu i\alpha$ that function as cardinal numbers (1 Cor 6:16 and Eph 5:31; 10:8; 2 Cor 11:24; Phil 1:27; Eph 4:4, 5; 1 Tim 3:2, 12; Titus 1:6). Next it examines thirty of the thirty-four occurrences of ϵv (1 Cor 3:8; 6:16, 17; 10:17; 11:5; 12:9, 11, 12 [2x], 13 [3x]; etc.). Then it identifies the possible implications and characterizations of "one" and the system that supports it in Pauline theology (with reference to Christology, soteriology, pneumatology, anthropology, ecclesiology, etc.). A five-page glossary is included. Giuliano is adjunct professor of NT exegesis and Greek at the Istituto Superiore di Scienze Religiose in Aquila. Buscemi has provided a two-page foreword.
