G. SEGALLA, *Il Quarto Vangelo come storia*, La Bibbia nella storia 23 (Bologna: Dehoniane, 2012, paper €8) 84 pp. Bibliography. ISBN: 978-88-10-40275-7.

This volume represents the first part of a very extensive introduction to John's Gospel that Segalla was working on prior to his death in July of 2011. After A. Filippi's four-page preface, it provides a three-page introduction to John's Gospel and a detailed outline of the whole project. Then it presents chapters on the story of Jesus and its redaction through an oral and written tradition; the guarantors of this story and their identity; the spatial-temporal coordinates; the cultural and religious coordinates; and the story of Jesus in the universal story. A six-page bibliography is included.
