A. D'ANNA AND E. VALERIANI (EDS.), *L'ultimo nemico di Dio. Il ruolo dell'Anticristo nel cristianesimo antico e tardoantico*, Primi secoli (Bologna: Dehoniane, 2013, paper €13.50) 151 pp. Indexed. ISBN: 978-88-10-45310-0.

After the editors' five-page introduction, this volume presents essays by E. Norelli on where the Antichrist came from—the Antichrist in the Johannine letters; J.-D. Kaestli on a new apocryphon to add to the dossier of the Antichrist—the *Revelatio Johannis* recently discovered in a Latin manuscript at Prague (with an Italian translation of the text by Norelli); Valeriani on the worker of evil in the apocryphal *Revelation of John*; and D'Anna on whether Simon Magus is the Antichrist—a note on *Acts of Peter*.
