M. MAZZEO, *La spiritualità del Nuovo Testamento. Ascolto e sequela*, Corso di teologia spirituale 3 (Bologna: Dehoniane, 2011, paper €57) 708 pp. Bibliography. ISBN: 978-88-10-54123-4.

After a 31-page introduction to the spiritual theology of the NT, Mazzeo, a Capuchin Franciscan who teaches biblical spirituality at the Università Antonianum in Rome and other institutions in Italy, discusses the originating spiritual experience—Jesus of Nazareth and the proclamation of the gospel. Next he treats the spirituality of the Gospels and Acts: Matthew—the ecclesial Gospel of “God with us”; Mark—the Gospel of Jesus the Messiah and Son of God; Luke-Acts—one work in two volumes; and John—the original Gospel. Then he considers the spirituality in Paul’s letters and other NT letters, with general treatments of Paul and his spirituality, as well as 1 Thessalonians, 1 Corinthians, Romans, Ephesians, and the catholic epistles (1 Peter, 2 Peter and Jude, James, 1–3 John). Finally he reflects on the spirituality of the book of Revelation. His work is part of a twelve-volume project on spiritual theology.
