This volume provides an introduction to Tyconius, a 4th-century theologian from Roman Africa, and the text of his *Liber regularum*, the oldest manual of biblical hermeneutics of the Christian West. The editors' seventeen-page introduction discusses Tyconius' life and works, the *Liber regularum*, its role in the history of exegesis, its hermeneutical approach and biblical-theological aspect, and Tyconius and Augustine. Then it presents an Italian translation of the seven rules of Tyconius' *Liber regularum* based on F. C. Burkitt's 1894 critical edition, *The Book of Rules of Tyconius*: the Lord and his body, the bipartite body of the Lord, the promises and the Law, species and genus, time, recapitulation, and the devil and his body.
